IQAC Meeting

The IQAC Meeting was called on 24th June, 2022.

➤ **Minutes of the earlier meeting were confirmed.**

The Following suggestion were made and decided upon:

1. Induction and orientation programs to be conducted for newly appointed staff and fresh batch of students respectively.
 - a. Since the college has reopened in the physical mode post pandemic, plans to be made for a smooth transaction of students.
 - b. To ease the students on the campus after the pandemic it was suggested that the mentors hold contact programmes with students. The counsellor could address mental health issues of students through some common contact programs. The Psychology department could coordinate these programs for the students.
2. Principal suggested that 'Learning Loss' for students due to the pandemic be taken into account by teachers while making the teaching plan. Initial weeks of teaching in the semester must be devoted to compensation of learning loss.
3. Admissions for 2022-23 are in progress. Students to be informed about the installment and freeship / scholarship facilities offered by the Management and the Government.
4. It was agreed by all members that the Learning Management System (LMS) platform of G-Suite be continued for conducting continuous assessment and also to supplement classroom teaching with online tools.
5. The Earn and Learn scheme to be restarted from 2022-23 for the needy students supported by management.
6. The Academic calendar was discussed and finalised for the year 2022-23.
 - a. A motivational leadership workshop must be arranged for teachers to boost this morale after the pandemic. Teachers to be trained in the use of ICT tools for teaching learning and add on programs.
 - b. A short-term course for teachers be arranged with TLC, Guru Angad Dev under Madan Mohan Malviya, Dr. Kartik to initiate this program on NEP.
7. Academic Audit to be conducted.
8. Proposals for research projects be invited from contractual full-time teachers, and an Avishkar workshop to be held for students.




- a. Infrastructure augmentation and repairs are in progress. IQAC observed that the work was progressing satisfactory.
9. Gender sensitization cell to be activated to conduct community programs in physical mode.
10. Self-Development program for non-teaching staff to be introduced. Some cash advance to be disburse.
11. MOUs with industry / institute to be reviewed.
 - a. Certificate courses by TISS to be continued in the year 2022-23.
 - b. Certificate and diploma courses for livelihood be explored in areas like fashion designing, Beautician, Interior Designing.
12. For the NAAC accreditation series of documentation and planning sessions to be arranged with external experts.

It is resolved that


- During the next academic year, a celebration be planned to commemorate the 75th Independence Day of India – Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav.


It is resolved that:

The IQAC coordinator welcomed the members to the second meeting of the Academic year 2020-2021 and read the previous minutes of meeting and the Action Taken Report related to the first meeting. The following points were discussed in the meeting.

Submission of AQAR→

- Start date: 10th March 2021; last date: 31st March 2021

Documentation→

- Dr. Ramraj will share the relevant formats with all the departments
- SSR will be prepared by Ms. Harpreet
- If there are any queries, teachers can contact Dr. Ramraj, Dr. Karthik, Ms. Nandita, Ms. Anitha and Mr. Dhananjay
- Ms Anitha suggested that for the monthly updation of documents for AQAR, seven files as per seven criteria be maintained in each department.
- The suggestive list of activities as per seven criteria need to include two invited lectures, one outreach program, one seminar, one research program, one quiz/game and one certificate course/ training program of minimum 30 hours per year.
- The best practices of value education and skill development be reflected in every activity.




Action Taken Report:

The following are the minutes of the IQAC Meeting conducted on 3rd January 2020 at 2.00 pm in the Aura Hall.

The Co-ordinator welcomed the members to the second meeting of the IQAC in the academic year 2019-20 and shared the minutes as well as the Action Taken Report related to the first meeting.

1. The Principal shared the details of the TISS program and a review was taken.
2. It was decided that the AQAR for the academic year 2018-19 be compiled and sent to NAAC.
3. The Principal informed that the first Advisory Committee meeting of the Star DBT Program would be held on 16th January 2020.
4. The Vice Principal Dr. Ramachandran suggested that the Annual Prize Distribution function be planned soon. The IQAC members discussed the broad guidelines and also the organization of the event.
5. The Principal suggested that an Academic Leaders' Conclave be hosted in the college so that eminent leaders from universities and colleges could meet and interact with the college faculty. She suggested that Prof. Varun Sahani, V.C., University of Goa and Prof. Suhas Pednekar, V.C., University of Mumbai would deliver the keynote addresses. The brochure and other details would be finalized by the IQAC.
6. The members suggested that Academic Audit of all departments be arranged.
7. Attendance committee would have to take serious measures to tackle poor attendance in some classes.
8. The Alumni Association registration would be taken up on the war footing.

Action Taken Report

1. AQAR for the academic year 2018-19 was submitted on 8th March 2020.
2. The first Advisory Committee meeting of the Star DBT Program was held on 16th January 2020. Dr. Garima Gupta and Prof. Meenakshi Munshi from DBT, Delhi and local advisory committee members Dr. Rajendra Shinde and Dr. Anita Kanwar visited the college. The Principal made presentation regarding the progress of the program.
3. Academic Leaders' Conclave was hosted on 27th January 2020 with two V.C.s as the eminent guests. Seventy eight participants including principals, directors and deans shared their ideas.
4. The Annual Day was celebrated on 27th January 2020.

Minutes of IQAC Meeting conducted on 6th June 2019 at 2.00 pm in the Aura Hall

The following are the minutes of the IQAC Meeting conducted on 6th June 2019 at 2.00 pm in the Aura Hall.

The Co-ordinator welcomed the members to the first meeting of the IQAC in the academic year 2019-20.

1. The I/C Principal informed the members about the appointment of full time teachers to the vacant posts. Twenty new appointments on contractual basis were made through an interview process. The Principal observed that this would strengthen the teaching faculty profile and enhance the teaching-learning process.
2. To upgrade and digitize the college functioning, the Principal informed the members that an ERP service provider has been engaged after the consultation with the management at the CDC meeting held in 2018-19. Since Mastersoft Solutions were already providing the software for admissions, it was decided to continue with them for a seamless upgradation. A complete solution including admission, attendance, examination, accounts and office administration modules has been introduced now. The complete admission process will now be online including payment of fees. The members discussed the ways to implement and execute the online process. A schedule for training of the faculty and office staff was drawn. It was decided that implementation would begin from the in-house students of Self-Financed Courses, Arts and Science streams, Commerce stream of the SY and TY classes. This would then be extended to the FY admissions. For this an orientation-cum-training session would be arranged for all the in-house students.
3. The co-ordinator impressed upon the need for documentation of activities so as to compile the annual reports. A format was introduced and accordingly a training program was organized for the faculty members on submission of data in the new online format. This would ensure proper organization and maintenance of records.
4. The college is offering a number of certificate and add-on courses to students. In the previous IQAC meeting, skill-development of students was highlighted. To consolidate the skill-development initiatives, the Principal has written to TISS for consideration to their NUSSD Program. The Principal was pleased to share that TISS has accepted the proposal prima facie and a meeting with the Director, NUSSD Program, TISS would be arranged soon.
5. All members unanimously agreed that many students faced emotional and mental health issues that were hampering their academic and career development. This needed to be addressed at the institutional level. It was decided that a series of meditation sessions and motivational interventions be planned for the same. A committee would be constituted and the Heartfulness Foundation, Brahm Kumari Mission and the Roohed-Life team would be collaborated with.



6. Since this year is the 550th Birth Anniversary of Guru Nanak Devji, a number of programs could be planned to mark the occasion. The Principal shared that the proposal for a seminar was accepted by the Indian Council for Philosophical Research and an amount of Rs. 200000/- (two lakh) was sanctioned for the same. The organizing committee of the seminar would make the necessary arrangements. It was also decided that the college would take the initiative to plant 5550 trees in and around the Mumbai. The NSS co-ordinator agreed to implement this and also to work towards collecting 550 bottles of blood through blood donation drives. A plan was drawn to inaugurate the tree planting drive and the Member of Parliament Shri. Rahul Shewale would be invited. Furthermore, the college would also initiate a Yoga out-reach program to the minimum of 550 people of the community on the occasion of Yoga Day.
7. It was observed that the college needed to develop e-content for teaching to ensure that the students could learn any time anywhere. A team of faculty members, who are experts in ICT, is constituted and entrusted with the task of training the staff.
8. The members of the IQAC suggested constructive measures towards promoting research in students. Faculty members who were awarded research projects by the University of Mumbai would engage students in related research areas and train them to present their work at the Avishkaar Research Festival.
9. It was decided that the exam committee meet to streamline the evaluation system further so as to make it more transparent. For instance, steps like assessment of students by external teachers, submission of question paper manuscripts in PDF format, improved display of exam guidelines and use of unfair means rules, etc. would go a long way in improving the system.
10. The Principal suggested that senior teachers and retired teachers be involved in the planning and decision making of the college.
11. It was suggested that proposal be sent for the Third Year in Botany (Six Papers) to strengthen the Science stream.

Action Taken Report

1. The appointed teachers participated in an induction program arranged by the IQAC.
2. All the admissions were successfully done online. Attendance through the ERP is being taken by the teachers. An analysis is obtained through the software. Attendance committee then takes a review of attendance defaulters. The financial transactions are cashless to a large extent due to the implementation of the online modes of payment.
3. Teachers were trained in the online submission of data related to all activities in August 2019. This will smoothen the AQAR submission process.
4. After a proposed meeting with TISS, the college was selected for the NUSSD Program. A Memorandum of Understanding was signed with TISS on 25th November 2019. A competency test was conducted for all SY and TY students; following which 750 students were enrolled in the certificate and diploma courses offered by TISS. Mr. Ram, a college



faculty, was appointed as the course co-ordinator. Lectures have started.

5. A group of seven teachers is trained in the techniques of meditation by the Heartfulness Foundation. A series of meditation sessions are arranged every Wednesday by Brother Peter from the Brahm Kumari Mission.
6. To mark the 550th Birth Anniversary of Guru Nanak Devji, the following programs were organized by the staff and students:

7. A two-day faculty development program on e-content is planned on 28th & 29th January 2020.
8. Twenty students are being guided by four faculty members in their respective research subjects.
9. In the subject of Foundation Course, the internal evaluation is conducted by the external examiners who are from other departments. Furthermore to improve exam system a number of measures are taken such as submission of question paper manuscripts in PDF format, improved display of exam guidelines and use of unfair means rules.
10. An Academic Planning Council comprising the senior teachers was constituted. It is also planned that an Advisory committee of some teachers who have superannuated, will be constituted.
11. The proposal for the Third Year in Botany (Six Papers) was submitted to the University of Mumbai.
